How manages the CBO? ADUA is managed by the Board of Directors; it also has an Executive Board responsible for day-to-day activities. It has a technical advisor, financial officer, a legal advisor and an International Coordinator responsible for organization's fundraising in Western countries. Also ADUA works with volunteers both from within and outside the country. The number of full-time-staff is 4, 9 part-time and 3 volunteers.
